Lernmanufaktur Ulm is a private learning studio based in Ulm, Germany, specialized in academic language education and structured learning support for teenagers and young adults.

Program Concept

The German Summer Intensive Program „Immerse in German“ is designed for students aged 15 to 18 with existing German knowledge at A2–B1 level.

The program combines:

- structured academic language instruction
- practical communication training
- cultural orientation within a German academic context

It is designed as a serious educational experience, not a leisure camp.
Each course runs for two weeks and can be booked as an independent module.

Academic Structure

Monday to Friday

Morning Session (09:00 – 12:00)

- Grammar and vocabulary development
- Reading and writing skills
- Academic language structures
- Targeted error correction

Afternoon Session (13:00 – 15:00)

- Spoken German and communication
- Discussions and guided practice
- Project-based tasks
- Cultural and contextual topics

5 hours of instruction per day
Focus on measurable progress and active participation

Small Groups & Learning Quality

Each group is limited to a maximum of 8 students.

This ensures:

- individual attention
- adaptive teaching pace
- a supportive learning atmosphere

Students are encouraged to actively participate, ask questions, and gain confidence using German in real-life contexts.

Teaching Staff

Courses are taught by qualified and experienced German language teachers with:

- experience teaching international students
- expertise in working with teenagers
- strong academic and pedagogical backgrounds

Teachers accompany the group consistently throughout the program, ensuring continuity and trust.

Cultural & Educational Excursions

The program includes two guided educational excursions, designed to connect language learning with German history and culture:

- Ulm Minster (Ulmer Münster)

A visit to the world's tallest church tower, focusing on historical, architectural, and cultural context.

- Wiblingen Abbey (Kloster Wiblingen)

An introduction to German monastic history and classical architecture, integrated with language-related tasks.

These excursions are educationally embedded into the program and are not just tourist activities.

Accommodation & Meals

Students stay in a partner hotel in Ulm.

Accommodation:

- Single room guaranteed
- No shared rooms with strangers
- Safe and supervised environment

Meals:

- Daily breakfast
- Lunch snack on teaching days

The program follows a structured daily routine appropriate for an academic course.

Supervision & Responsibility

We place strong emphasis on:

- clear daily schedules
- defined responsibilities
- transparent communication

Students are expected to behave responsibly and respectfully during the entire program.

Each module includes arrival the day before the course starts and departure the day after the course ends.
